**Speed Learning Sessions** (Virtual – April 9, 2025) These dynamic, fast-paced sessions are designed for presenters to share impactful, high-level practices and initiatives that have enhanced their state chapters. Presenters will have 15 minutes to deliver their content, followed by 5 minutes for Q&A

Interactive Workshops (Virtual – April 9, 2025)
These 60-minute workshops provide attendees with handson, practical strategies for implementing multicultural education in their classrooms or communities. Workshops should be interactive, promoting active participation and offering concrete takeaways.

**Graduate Student Virtual Poster Session** (Virtual - April 9, 2025)

This virtual space will allow graduate students to share their research with recorded 5-minute videos and an asynchronous Q&A platform.
